EDPR NA has developed more than 12,000 megawatts (MW) of wind, solar and energy storage projects and operates more than 11400 MW of onshore utility-scale and 312 MW of distributed generation scale renewable energy. Every project is built to the highest standards of environmental due diligence, promoting the responsible use of land to power the equivalent of 3 million homes across North America to date.
